PRES NOTES:



Wednesday, April 9 Che-Hanna meeting.

The topic of the meeting will be "Learning about Precious Metal Clays". Inga will bring examples of clays and tools used. Metal Clays are made of very small particles of metal such as silver, gold, copper, bronze that are mixes with an organic binder and water. This artform originated in Japan in 1990. This clay can be shaped like any clay by using hands or molds. After drying, the clay can be fired using a small torch or kiln. The clay is burned away, leaving behind the metal. When making designs, one has to keep in mind that there will be shrinkage. PMC is readily available at your local craft stores and online. Inga has used Prometheus clay with the Pebble Pups. She leaned about this medium at Wildacres many years ago. There may be some examples and ideas from John Milligan. Inga.



Inga has a bad cold virus.


Mr. Prez., Bob still has shoulder pain from his, not one, but two, falls during the winter on snow covered ice.
