
MAY NEWS REPORT

Sunday, August 17 Kirby Park, Nichols, NY


Picnics are: meet at Noon, eat at 1:00 P.M. Dish to Pass, Bring own table service.

Fieldtrip: Jeff Benish suggested trips for Herkimers.


Good of the Order: Activites for Summer Picnics was discussed.
